Guidelines

Abstract Guidelines:

Abstracts should be 300-500 words and clearly outline the research objectives, methodology, findings, and implications for sustainable development.

Full papers Guidelines:

Full papers should be between 4,000 and 6,000 words.

- Title: Include the short title (max 12 words), author names, affiliations, and contact details for the corresponding author.
- Keywords: A maximum of 6 keywords.
- Introduction: Provide context, and purpose of the paper, linking relevant literature with the study's objectives.
- **Literature Review:** Summarize key theoretical foundations and previous work on the subject.
- Methodology: Describe the study's methods, including sampling and analysis techniques, and discuss ethical considerations.
- **Findings:** Present data clearly using tables, figures, and statistical tests.

- Discussion: Interpret the findings in relation to existing knowledge, and suggest areas for further research.
- Recommendations: Offer concise and actionable recommendations.
- References: Use APA style (version 20).
- Tables and Figures: Number consecutively and provide descriptive titles and legends.
- Acknowledgments: Mention any funding or assistance received.

Peer-Review:

Submissions are reviewed by the two members of the scientific committee

Type of papers accepted:

Papers may be research papers, technical papers, case studies, or literature reviews.
